Conference Overview

The International Conference on Holistic Pedagogy in a Changing World: Nurturing Global Citizens was organized in a hybrid mode on October 25 & 26, 2023. The event was hosted by Kannur Salafi B.Ed. College in collaboration with the Department of Education, Mother Teresa Women's University, Kodaikanal; District Institute of Education & Training, Rajinder Nagar, New Delhi; Farook Training College, Kozhikode; and MES's Pillai College of Education and Research, Chembur.



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


On a scale of 1 to 5, 5 being the highest, how would you rate the event?




What are the three things that you liked the most in this conference?






How would you rate the organization and scheduling of sessions?


Count of How helpful was the organisers?
