


Programs Conducted During 2022-23

Targeted at M.Ed students, this lecture covered the importance of proper referencing in academic writing and emphasized research ethics.





One Week Induction & Bridge Course for B.Ed & M.Ed Students 7th - 12th October 2022

Day 1 (07/10/2022)

Farook Training College has conducted a four-day bridge course for first-year B. Ed and M. Ed students from 07/10/2022 to 12/10/2022. The objective of the bridge course was to enable the students to be teacher educators and to introduce the features of the BEd course to them. Principal Dr. T Muhammad Saleem inaugurated the program, and he addressed students with an inspiring speech. On the first day, we began the session with Farook Geeth. It was a perfect beginning for the four-day long bridge course. Our co-ordinator, Mr. Fasalul Abid, took attendance and welcomed Dr. Afeef Tharavattathu to led the session on the topic 'Campus Extends to the Community'. The session was packed with infotainment. The session created awareness about the importance of community engagement and created a spark in student's minds to be involved in social activities.

The second session was also led by Dr. Afeef Tharavattathu on the topic 'Orientation to Extension activities'. In this session, we discussed the community extension activities of ftc in detail He introduced the Garden of farook training college and there were interesting stories behind each plant. Dr. Afeef talked about the morality and ethics of Farook Training College. He gave some instructions regarding college rules. He introduced different projects under NSS such as Hridhyapoorvam, Bhoomithra Sena and blood donation, etc. His main purpose in teaching is to serve the community. That was his message to us.

The third session was led by the principal Dr. T. Mohammed Saleem on 'The Chemistry of Togetherness'. He highlighted "Mother is the first teacher for all of us". He talked about the qualities of an inspiring teacher and emphasized the role of a parent as a teacher. He gave a follow-up activity for students. The session was very helpful for students to understand the heart and soul of Farook Training college.



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Day-2 (10/10/2022)

The second day's bridge course began with Nowfal sir's session on "The Art and Heart of Teaching". The central theme of his session was "Teaching is an art and teacher is an artist". None of our educational institutions focus ever on moulding up a great human being, but he enforced the fact that no one will ever become a great teacher unless he is a better human. He expanded his ideas through striking events

in his life and he never failed to entertain his listeners with songs, stories and other activities. The main points in his class revolves around the truth that none of us are promoted to do the things which an ordinary kid can't bear. We swayed along with him and stretched both our minds and bodies to reach the level of a kid. His explanation of various incidents were heart touching, which was an inspiration for many of us to love this profession. All of his points were crystal clear and we cannot thank him enough for such an amazing session.

Campus walk conducted by FTC helped us to know more about our campus surroundings. We were enlightened about the history of this prestigious campus by Afeef sir, Farooq sir and Nowfal sir. Apart from that we saw various sister institutions of Farook Management. As a part of campus walk, we could see the resting place of the eminent scholar Abussabah, the founder of Farook college, and also the home he lived. Afeef sir shared his funny personal experiences inside the campus, which made the session more interesting.



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Day-3 (11/10/2022)

The first session on Teacher Behaviour by Shareef Sir was an eye-opener. Mr. Shareef sir handled the session brilliantly with his admirable witty nature. We were thinking and laughing simultaneously all the time. The main slogan put forward by the speaker was "Teaching is an art & Teacher is an artist". He reminded us about the importance and impact of each and every word of a teacher through different stories. He also mentioned his life story of transformation from a very negative

person to a thankful and thoughtful Teacher. The session which aimed at inculcating good values, patience, empathy and the like in our young teacher minds was completely successful by all aspects.

Second session was an awareness class against the usage of drugs. The session was held by Jayarajan Sir, Sub Inspector, Nadakkavu Police Station. He shared some of his very relevant experiences. The most saddening fact we realized is that the drug mafia has succeeded in influencing even our primary student community upto a certain level. The influence of drugs is evidently visible in most of the cruel incidents which startled human conscience. He concluded his talk by introducing the governmental systems to prevent drug abuse. Students got opportunities to clear their doubts and also to share their relevant experiences. The significant importance of creating awareness against drug abuse was clearly underlined by this infusing session.

Third Session was conducted by Salahudeen MP, Radio artist and former Media one programmer. This session was titled 'Tuning our tone' . He beautifully explained different methods to improve our Guruvani radio programme. He said that everyone's sound is beautiful with microphone. We also realized that writing a programme script is an integral part of preparation. This session was highly inspirational.



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Day-4 (12/10/2022)

The last day of bridge course (12/10/22) began with the morning session of Dr. Niranjana KP mam (9.30-11.15) on the 'Structure of B. Ed. program'. She

discussed the B. Ed. syllabus and the overall structure of the course. After the break, Dr. Jouhar Munavvir T led the second session (11.30-1.00) on 'Student -Teacher Who and What'. He Potraited many examples on how a teacher should be. Both parents and teachers play important role in molding a child into a humane person.

As part of NSS Anti-drug awareness program quiz competition and panel discussion was conducted. Six BEd groups and MEd actively participated in the discussion. The discussion was concluded by Dr. Jouhar Munavvir.



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
Day-5 (14/10/2022)



cards which are mandatory for the issue of books were also distributed. The session came to an end with students visiting the library.

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Orientation Programme for M.Ed Students



21st October 2022




