




Report

Seven Days Faculty Enrichment Programme (FEP) on 'Concerns of Academic Research in Social Science' 10th -16th May 2023

The Faculty Development Programme on Concerns of Academic Research in Social Sciences took place from May 10th to May 16th, 2023. Its primary objective was to equip faculty members with essential knowledge and skills in academic research. The program covered a wide range of topics, including research ethics, methodology, and data analysis using both commercial and open source software. Distinguished experts in the field shared their expertise and insights with the 390 participants, who included faculty members from various institutions and disciplines within the social sciences field.

The FEP commenced with an inaugural session on May 10th, 2023, chaired by Dr. Reni Francis, Principal of PCER. In her opening remarks, Dr. Francis emphasized the importance of participants becoming focused researchers with strong motives and values. Prof. Nasreen from Aligarh Muslim University, in her speech, commended the organizing institutions for planning and collaborating on the FEP. She acknowledged the significant contributions of academic researchers in social sciences across various research departments in the country. 
SESSION 1: Date: 10th May 2023 (Wednesday) Topic: Fundamentals of Research, Research Ethics, and Plagiarism Speaker: Dr. Gabriel Simon Thattil


SESSION 2: Date: 11th May 2023 (Thursday) Topic: Research Problem and Sample Selection Speaker: Dr. Bharthi Kaushik




