




Academic Writing Workshop 31 March 2023






State Level Workshop on Research & Publication Ethics 21st March 2023








Workshop on Tool Preparation 5th November 2022










One Day Workshop on Introduction to SPSS for Statistical Analysis 17th September 2021






PhD Open Defence/ Viva- Voce Examination - Mr. Muneer 30th July 2021
