

#### Seven Days Faculty Enrichment Programme (FEP) on 'Concerns of Academic Research in Social Science' 10th -16th May 2023

The Faculty Development Programme on Concerns of Academic Research in Social Sciences took place from May 10th to May 16th, 2023. Its primary objective was to equip faculty members with essential knowledge and skills in academic research. The program covered a wide range of topics, including research ethics, methodology, and data analysis using both commercial and open source software. Distinguished experts in the field shared their expertise and insights with the 390 participants, who included faculty members from various institutions and disciplines within the social sciences field.

The FEP commenced with an inaugural session on May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, chaired by Dr. Reni Francis, Principal of PCER. In her opening remarks, Dr. Francis emphasized the importance of participants becoming focused researchers with strong motives and values. Prof. Nasreen from Aligarh Muslim University, in her speech, commended the organizing institutions for planning and collaborating on the FEP. She acknowledged the significant contributions of academic researchers in social sciences across various research departments in the country. Prof. (Dr.) Mohammed Saleem, who felicitated the participants and organizers, reminded the research community of the importance of commitment to academic research. He emphasized that research should contribute to society; otherwise, it would be a waste of time and considered wrongdoing.



## One Week Short Term Certificate Course on Inclusive Education 20th - 26th February 2023

The Inter University Centre for Disability Studies (IUCDS), MG University, Kottayam, ISS College of Teacher Education, Perinthalmanna, and IQAC Farook Training College, Calicut jointly organized a one-week online short term certificate course on "Inclusive Education" from 20th to 26th February 2023. This course aimed to teach participants about inclusive education, curricular issues, and alternative means for assessment and evaluation.

The course was attended by a total of 315 members, including students and faculties from various colleges and universities. All the participants were provided with their username and password to access the course. Dr. Aseel Abdul Wahid, Assistant Professor Farook Training College, and Dr. Naseerali M.K, Assistant Professor, ISS College of Teacher Education were the course coordinators of the program. MR. Rasheed C.P and Mr. Sony Damodaran, Assistant Professors of ISS College of Teacher Education, were the organizing secretaries. Dr. Baburaj M.K, Director IUCDS, MG University Kottayam, Dr. T Mohammed Saleem, Principal Farook Training College and Mr. Samad Mankada, Principal ISS college of teacher education were the program convenors.

The course was a self-paced learning session via LMS, consisting of video sessions, reading materials, and graded assignments. It followed the four quadrant approach to MOOC courses, with 3+1 hours daily. The course delivery and resources were made available offline through the LMS (Moodle). The course scoring and grading were based on the activities organized in the course, such as assignments, quizzes, and tests. The assessment and evaluation were conducted based on each module's assignment, practice works, and quizzes, along with an achievement test based on the entire module at the end of the course. The certification was based on the participation and grades obtained by the participants. Soft copies of certificates were issued to all eligible participants.

Overall, the one-week online short term certificate course on "Inclusive Education" was a successful program attended by a significant number of participants from various colleges and universities. It provided a platform for participants to learn about inclusive education and various strategies to address curricular issues and alternative means for assessment and evaluation. The organizers and coordinators have done an excellent job in structuring and delivering the course content and resources through the LMS platform. The issuance of soft copies of certificates added value to the course's participants, making it a useful experience.
