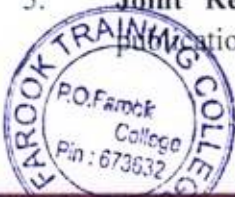

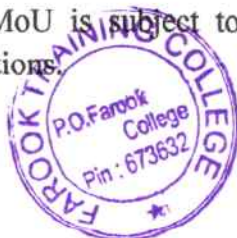

WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

- E) iLAB Innovation Laboratory, the Second Party iLAB – Innovation Laboratory is a non-profit organization founded in 2016 to empower underprivileged coastal communities through interventions in education, economic upliftment, and women empowerment by providing equal opportunities.
- F) iLAB Innovation Laboratory, the Second Party, is Supported by Kozhikode Municipal Corporation

CLAUSE 1- CO-OPERATION

1. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
2. First Party and Second Party cooperation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party, providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
3. The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate



4. with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter here of and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2- SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 1. Skill enhancement:** The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe close cooperation would greatly benefit the student community by enhancing their skills and knowledge.
- 2. Curriculum Design:** First party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the volunteers of the second party fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 3. Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working careers. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops /Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 4. Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Early Childhood Care and Education.

9. Farook Training College, the First Party, has no financial commitment to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt with separately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 – VALIDITY

1. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period Farook Training College, the First Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps to implement this MOU. Any act on the part of the First Party, after the termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence, etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU
2. Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5- RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors. The relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations, or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.




