Module 1: Foundations of Communicative English

MODULE 1 - 3 Hrs

Overview:

This module introduces the principles of communicative Language Teaching and its

relevance to the classroom. It covers the basic concepts of communication, language

functions, and effective use of language in teaching. Teachers will explore how to develop

both their own and their students' language skills through practical communication

activities.

Key Topics:

• Introduction to Communicative Language Teaching.

• Language functions in teaching: requesting, explaining, questioning

• Effective verbal and non-verbal communication

Module 2: Enhancing Speaking and Listening Skills.

MODULE 2 - 10 Hrs

Overview:

Key Topics:

Module 3: Developing Reading and Writing Skills in the Classroom.
