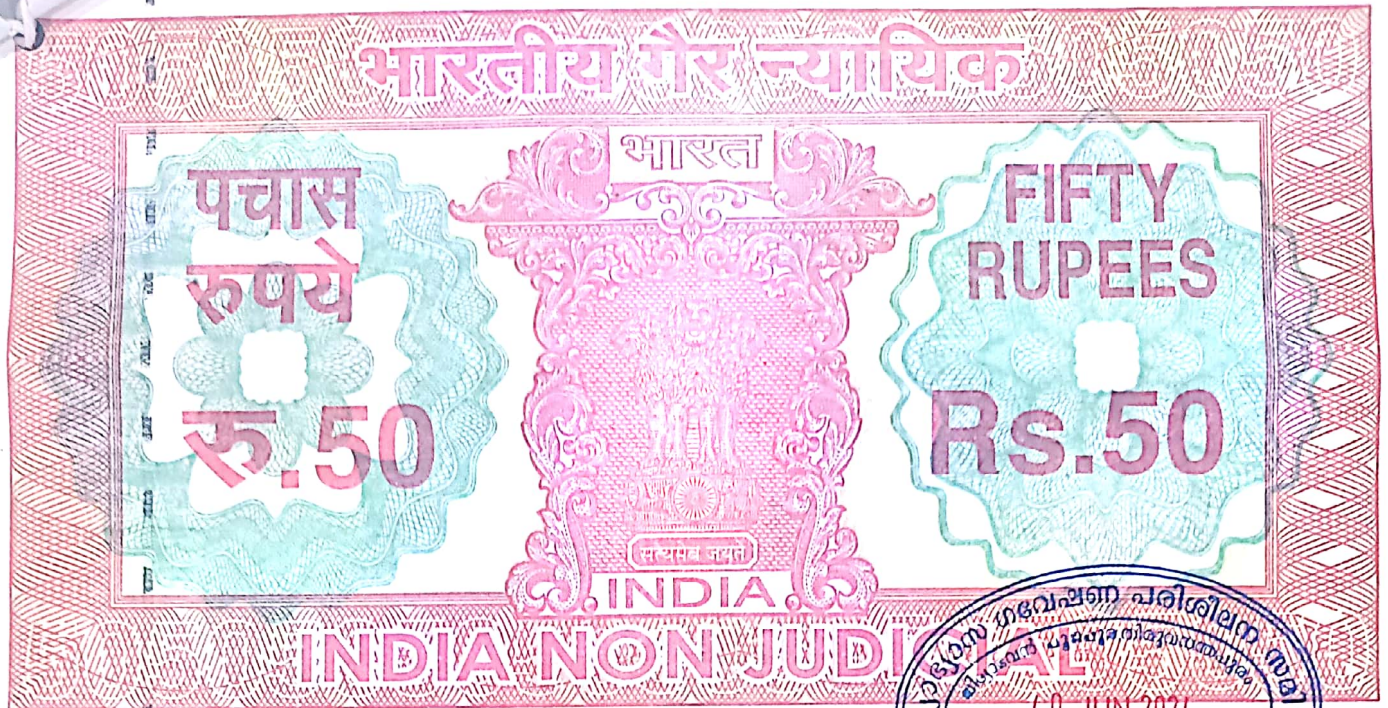




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## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN FAROOK TRAINING COLLEGE, CALICUT AND SCERT, KERALA

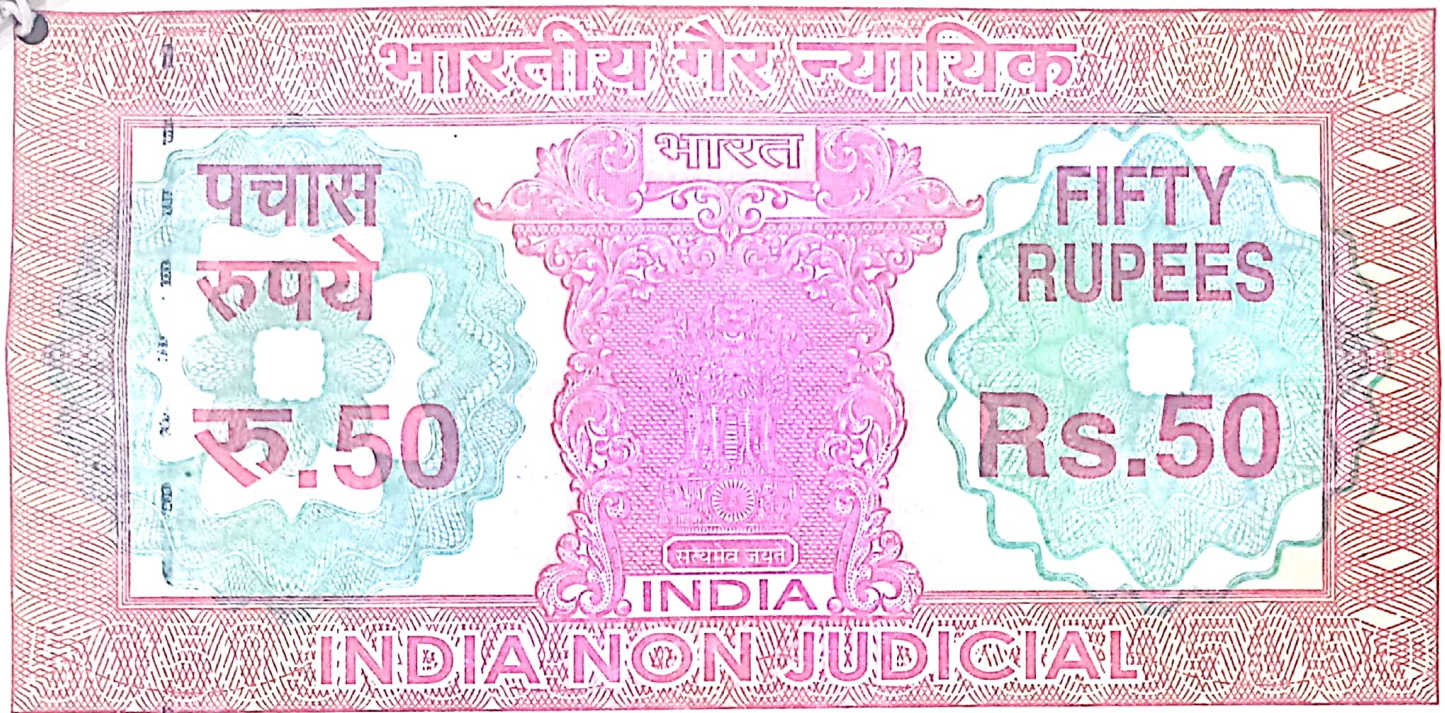

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## CLAUSE 2: SCOPE

The scope of this MoU encompasses the following key provisions:

**2.1 Financial and Resource Support by SCERT, Kerala:** The second party, SCERT, Kerala, commits to providing financial support for the Young Scholars Enrichment Programme. The second party will organize and conduct workshops essential for the successful implementation and completion of the Young Scholars Enrichment Programme.

**2.2 Contribution by Farook Training College:** The first party agrees to contribute to the project by assigning MEd students for active participation in data collection. In recognition of the contribution made by the participating MEd students, the second party, will remunerate each student with an honorarium of 3500 rupees. Upon completion of data collection, the first party is obligated to submit a utilization certificate to the second party.

**2.3 Submission of Project Findings:** Following the conclusion of the University examination, the first party will provide both soft and hard copies of the project findings, including a comprehensive review, methodology, results, and implications for further study, analysis, publication and policy-making.
